4. Start your capability assessment

To start your Digital Capability Self Assessment. Select Go to Question 1



You will be presented with a range of capabilities, read the statement for each capability, then use the sliders (capability scores explained below) to self assess your current capability then self assess your required capability

Previous question: Throughout your assessment you can return to the previous questions at any time and edit your responses, remember to use **Save and continue** to record your new assessment answer.

Exit self assessment: This will save all responses to the point at which you exit. You can return later to complete the remainder of the assessment, when you return to the Learning Portal your Digital Capability Self Assessment will be available from your **Current courses**.

Skip: Will enable you to move to the next question, this will not save any response you may have made to the assessment question.

There are two general questions at the end of the assessment, you can use the slider to **Strongly disagree** through to **Strongly agree** or anywhere in between.

6. Review and submit

When you **Save and continue** the last question you will be presented with a **Review** of your assessment, use the + to expand and review your responses.





You can use **Previous question** to navigate back through your answers, should you need to make any amendments. Once you are happy with your responses you can **Submit self assessment**
