

Training

The library offers tailored training to support evidence-based practice. We offer sessions on critical appraisal, reflective writing, health literacy, and literature searching. Our courses count towards your CPD and revalidation.

Training is available for individuals or groups. Sessions are held virtually via MS Teams, or at venues across the Trust. Contact the library to discuss your needs.

Library Hot-Desking Room

Room 119 is the hot-desking room on the first floor at Moseley Hall Hospital, located directly above the main library. There are six computers with MS Office applications, internet and printing facilities.

If you are using a memory stick, please note that only encrypted memory sticks can be used.

The room can be accessed all round the clock, available seven days a week with your Trust swipe badge. Temporary access passes are available from Library staff.

Go to www.healthlibrariesmidlands.nhs.uk to search for items including e-books. Log in using your library card number and password to place reservations.

Library Collection

Our book collection focuses on geriatric medicine and rehabilitation, and also covers nursing, management, and general work skills. We also have leisure fiction, educational games, reminiscence materials, a wellbeing collection, CDs and DVDs, and resources to support the BCHC staff networks.

24-Hour Access

The library is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. It is normally staffed during office hours; and in the absence of library staff, access is by Trust ID swipe badge. There is a self-issue machine which can be used for borrowing and returning items belonging to the library, whilst items from other libraries can be left on the trolley and will be dealt with by staff.



Borrowing

The standard loan period is six weeks with a maximum limit of sixteen items and requests at one time. Loans are automatically renewed up to five times unless recalled by another user. Recalled loans must be returned by the due date.

When the maximum renewal limit is reached, proof that the loan is still in your possession is required if you wish to keep it for longer. You can send a photo or bring the item to the library. Otherwise, the loan must be returned.

Postal loans and Returns

If you can't get to Moseley during office hours, we'll send your chosen library items to your BCHC site via internal post. We'll add an extra two weeks to your loan period to allow for time in transit. We also accept returns in the internal mail.

OpenAthens

A BCHC OpenAthens account gives you access to electronic resources purchased by the NHS locally or nationally. Register at <https://openathens.nice.org.uk/> or contact the library for assistance.

Online Journals

For easy access to thousands of full-text journal articles online, add the LibKey Nomad extension to your browser. This will show BCHC access options for any articles you find. You can download documents immediately where available, or click to order from the library. Get the browser extension at <https://thirdiron.com/downloadnomad/>

Document Request Service

Literature Search Service
