


Right Help, Right Time

The refreshed 'Right Help, Right Time' is essential guidance for everyone who works with children, young people, and their families in Birmingham.

What's New:

- Refreshed comprehensive indicators in the layers of need
- New 'Contents' section
- Greater emphasis on sharing information to safeguard children
- Enhanced guidance on Children Out of Sight and Children who are Electively Home Educated
- Enhanced information alongside 'Right Help, Right Time' relating to learning disabilities
- Details on how to resolve professional disagreements about Safeguarding Children (previously 'Resolution and Escalation' policy)
- The content reflects the latest Working Together guidance
