## Overview

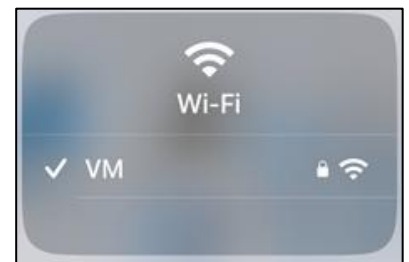
This guide explains how to use the **GlobalProtect VPN** on your Trust iPad to access the **Intranet Datix, Datix, Nutricia and Abena**.

You must be in the **VPN iPad group** to use this service. If you do not see the **GlobalProtect** app on your iPad, please contact **DTS Helpdesk**.

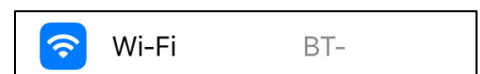
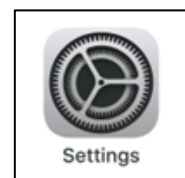
## Connect to Wi-Fi

Make sure your iPad is connected to any Wi-Fi network (home, Trust site, or secure public). If you're having trouble with Wi-Fi please go to Troubleshooting– Connect to Wi-Fi.



## Troubleshooting – Connecting to Wi-Fi

- Go to the **Settings App**
- Click on **Wi-Fi** and connect to available network



# Connecting to VPN on a BCHC iPad

## Open GlobalProtect

On the iPad Home Screen, select the **GlobalProtect** icon



## Sign In

Enter your Trust login details:

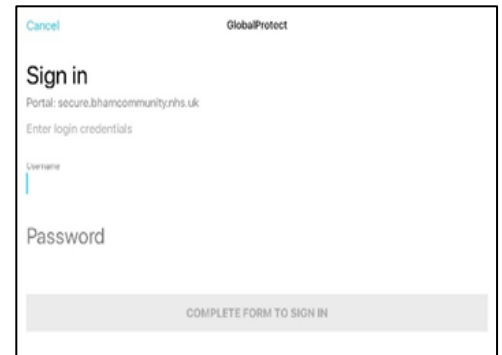
Username: Your email address ( you must add **@bhamcommunity.nhs.uk** at the end of your username e.g. username**@bhamcommunity.nhs.uk** )

Password: your normal Windows Apollo password

## Select **Sign In**

Once signed in, you're connected to the VPN. This only needs to be done once.

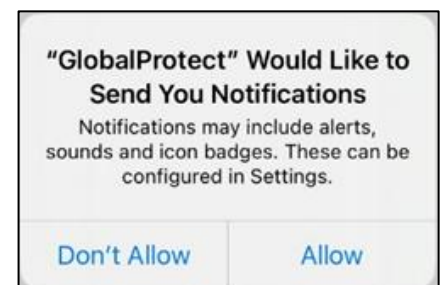
The iPad will remember your details.



## Notifications

Once you sign in you will receive a notification message:

- Select **Allow**
- Read Your Privacy Message
- Select **Continue**
