## Overview

If you are working somewhere that does **not have Trust Wi-Fi**, you can still get online by using your work phone as a **mobile Wi-Fi hotspot**.

Your mobile phone contains a **SIM card** which allows the phone to **connect** to the **Internet**

You can **share** this **Internet access** by turning your phone into a **Mobile Hotspot**

Other devices such as a Laptops and iPads can **connect** to the **Internet** via the **Mobile Hotspot**, this is known as **Internet Tethering**

As Internet Tethering uses a lot of power, you may find that Internet Tethering works better if your phone is charging while you are using the Mobile Hotspot

## How to enable a Mobile Hotspot on your (Samsung) phone

Turn on your Trust phone and enter your password

- **Swipe down** from the **top** of the Home screen once, using **one finger**

You should now see the **Settings** icon  in the **top right** corner of the **screen**


- Select the **Settings** icon
- Select **Connections**
- Select **Mobile Hotspot and Tethering**
- Select the slider  to **turn on** the **Mobile Hotspot**

A pop-up message will display **'Turn off Wi-Fi? - To use Mobile Hotspot, Wi-Fi needs to be turned off.'**

- Select **Turn off**
- Your Mobile Hotspot will now be **On** 
- Select the words **Mobile Hotspot** to view the information

The **'Connecting with password'** information will display

Leave this screen displaying or note down the phone name and password, you will need it to connect your Laptop to the Mobile Hotspot




# How to Connect to a Wi-Fi Hotspot

## Connecting your Laptop to the Mobile Hotspot

- Turn on your **Trust Laptop** and **log in**
- Select the  **Wi-Fi icon** from the system tray at the bottom right of the screen
- Select the **>** button (alongside the Wi-Fi icon) to open the list of available networks
- Select **your Phones Name** (the mobile name displaying on your phone or the one you wrote down earlier)
- Click **Connect**
- Enter the **Password** (the password displaying on your phone or the one you wrote down earlier)
- Select **Next**


When the connection has been made your phone name will be displayed



## Disconnecting your Laptop from the Mobile Hotspot

- Select the  **Wi-Fi icon** from the system tray at the bottom right of the screen
- Select the **>** button (alongside the Wi-Fi icon) to open the list of available networks
- Select **Disconnect**

Your laptop will connect to the trust's Wi-Fi automatically the next time you log in



## How to turn off a Mobile Hotspot on your (Samsung) phone

Turn on your Trust phone and enter your password

- **Swipe down** from the **top** of the Home screen once, using **one finger**

You should now see the **Settings** icon  in the **top right** corner of the **screen**
