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### Overview

The Conditions functionality in Rio uses SNOMED clinical codes. Conditions can be viewed in the Indicator's panel of the Clinical Portal or recorded via the Conditions link in the Case Record folder. Conditions may also be recorded via links found within Assessment forms.

- Click Menu
- Click Quick Menu
- Click Client's View
- Search for your Client

#### The Clinical Portal - Client's View screen will display

Access the Navigation Pane (right)

- Click Case Record
- Click <u>Conditions</u>

The Conditions screen will display

- Click Add (bottom)
- Click the green plus #

The SNOMED search screen displays


- Click in the **Browser** text box
- Type the name of the Condition
- Select required filter via radio button if required
- Click the magnifying glass


The **Search Result(s)** display on the **left** of the screen and are listed in alphabetical order. Dependent on the quantity of results a <u>click here</u> link will display to expand the search results list.

• Click the required Condition

This will then display in right SNOMED Concept Hierarchy pane

- Click  $\odot$  to **select** the required condition
- Click Add to Client Record
- Comment: Enter if required
- Condition Onset Date: Enter if Known
- Fetal Diagnosis: Enter if Known
- Click Save
