Overview

Dependency levels are used by the Children's & Families Division within our Trust. The Dependency levels are set in line with the 'Right Help, Right Time' guidance used by Birmingham Early Years to assist professionals to identify the support that a child, young person, or family might need and how best this support can be provided.

Recording a Dependency

- Click Menu
- Click Quick Menu
- Click Client's View
- Search for the Client

The Clinical Portal Client's View screen will display

Click the CF Dependency Levels tab (top)


CF Dependency Levels

The tab displays in two panes:

Dependency Levels – this displays all dependencies that have been recorded

Dependency Level Maintenance – where the dependency information is created and updated In **Dependency Level Maintenance** pane (located on right)

- Click the **Dependency Level** folder
- Click the Create Dependency Level link





The CF Dependency Levels screen will display

Complete the form

Recorded Date/Time: Use date/time recorded


• Specialty: As required

The **Dependency Level** screen now displays the information you have just recorded

• Click the Client's name on the banner bar to return to the main Clinical Portal – Clients' View screen

The **Dependency Levels** tab will display

Click the Summary tab to return to the standard view

Viewing Dependency Levels

Once a Dependency Level as been created it can be viewed via the Dependency Level pane.

- Click Menu
- Click Quick Menu
- Click Client's View
- · Search for the Client

The Clinical Portal Client's View screen will display

Click the CF Dependency Levels tab (top)

Updating a Dependency Level

If a Child's Dependency Level changes it can be updated

- Open the Child's Clinical Portal Client's View
- Open the **Dependency Level** tab
- Click the **Dependency Level** folder
- Click the **Update Dependency Level** link

A new window opens displaying the **Dependency Level – Update** screen

Maximise the window by clicking on the maximise icon (top right of window)

Click the Change Level/End Dependency link for the dependency you want to update

A new window will open which displays the previous Dependency Level

Maximise the window by clicking on the maximise icon (top right of window)



- Change Dependency Level as required
- Change Start Date/Time as required
- **Update Comment** if required
- Click Save

The **Dependency Level** window will refresh and display with the updated information

- Click X to close the CF Dependency Level window
- Click X to close the Dependency Level Update window

The **Dependency Level** tab will display

• Click the Client's Name link on the banner bar (top left) to refresh the screen

The updated Dependency Level will now display

Viewing Dependency Level History

Rio generates a report style view of the Dependency Level History

- Open the Child's Clinical Portal Client's View
- Open the **Dependency Level** tab
- Click the **Dependency Level** folder
- Click the <u>Dependency Level History</u> link

A new window opens displaying the **Dependency Historical View** screen. Maximise window.

- Select your Dependency Specialty from the picklist
- Click OK

The **Dependency Historical View** report displays, the report can be printed if necessary.
