

Completing Data Security Awareness eLearning on the Virtual Campus Internet Explorer has been phased out. It is best to use Google Chrome for this course.

1. Once you have logged into the Virtual Campus, click on the Mandatory Training link




You can scroll through different sections using the dots below the section icons




3. Click on the "View" button





## Data Security Refresher 2022




Follow the instructions on how to complete the course.

The Data Security Course has three sections of training material, followed by a 14 question assessment (the pass mark is 12/14) – if you do not pass the assessment, you can retake it.

You need to work through the three sections in the left hand column on the course. Each section has several components – all of these components must be completed for the section to record as complete

The panel on the left shows the different sections in the course. The panel on the right shows the topics within the current section. You need to work through all the topics before you can move on to the next section




Each of the sections comprises of a series of videos. In the final section, you will be presented with an interactive video where you will need to click on the appropriate areas in order to move forward




Once you have completed the final section, you will move on to the quiz.



If the course freezes at any time and will not recover, try clicking on the Exit activity button and then reload the course. The course should reopen where you left off




6. Once you have passed the course, click on "Exit Activity" to record the result
